Your children will bring home Seesaw notes this afternoon. We encourage all families to download the app on their phones and enable push notifications. It provides an efficient way of communicating and keeping you informed on what's happening in the class and around the school.

AGM / Governing Council

Our Annual General Meeting will be held in a few weeks (date to be confirmed) and we invite all interested parents to attend. At the AGM nominations will be taken for Governing Council and Office bearers will be elected. The Governing Council plays an important role in accountability, policy review and representing the parent body in decision making. They meet two evenings a term for approximately 60-90 minutes. Nomination forms will be available at the Meet and Greet evening or you may request one from the office. Parents are able to self-nominate.

All types of School Card applications are now online.

You can access the online forms from any device that gets internet, including mobile devices, such as tablets and smart phones, as well as laptops and computers.

Applying online is easy! Simply follow the steps below.

- STEP 1** Visit sa.gov.au/education/schoolcard
- STEP 2** Select the type of School Card you would like to apply for (for example 'Type A') and follow the prompts.
- STEP 3** Complete all mandatory fields.
Please note: you cannot submit your application unless all mandatory fields are complete.
- STEP 4** Once you have completed a page click on the 'NEXT' button.
- STEP 5** Once you have filled out all pages click the 'SUBMIT' button.
Please note: if you exit the form without clicking 'SUBMIT' your details will be lost.

You can save the form, and return to complete it at another time, by clicking on the 'SAVE' button.
