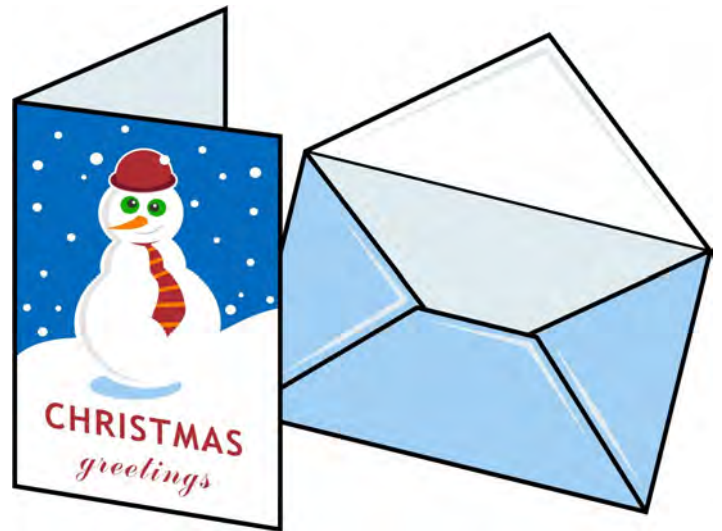
Please make note of the following dates for the first 2 weeks of school.
